3 25-10-2019 Petitioners seek bail in anticipation of their arrest in connection with Sessions Trial No. 210 of 2011, arising out of Ujiyarpur P.S. Case No. 43 of 2010 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 366 and 376 of the Indian Penal Code.

As per FIR, there is allegation of kidnapping of kidnapping of daughter of the informant

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioners is that there is no specific allegation against the petitioners and later on final form was submitted and during trial summons were issued and no material has come against them.

Heard learned APP, who has opposed the prayer for



anticipatory bail of the petitioners.

In view of above facts and circumstances, this application is disposed of with direction to the petitioners to surrender and pray for regular bail, which shall be considered on the basis of materials available on the record, without being prejudiced by this order and, if possible, to be disposed of on the same day.
