ORAL ORDER

2 30-07-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends her arrest in connection
with Barauli P.S. Case no. 200 of 2019, registered under
Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

The accusation is of recovery of 17 bottles, each
containing 180 ML India made foreign liquor from the house of
the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that it
would appear from the F.I.R. that at the time of raid of the joint
house of the petitioner, the petitioner was not present there.
Further submission is that petitioner, who is lady, has no
knowledge about keeping of liquor by her family members.
The petitioner has no criminal antecedent.



Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail, in the event of her arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Addl. Sessions Judge-II-cum-Special Judge, Gopalganj in connection with Barauli P.S. Case No. 200 of 2019, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
