2 29-07-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and

learned counsel for the State.

In this case, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory
bail in connection with Motihari Town P.S. Case No.238 of
2018, registered for the offence punishable under Sections 341,
323, 498 (A), 494 and 379 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the co-accused including the
petitioner is to have assaulted the informant due to non-
fulfillment of demand of dowry, however, counsel for the
petitioner submits that there is general and omnibus allegation
against the petitioner and the petitioner is the son of his 'Mama'.

Looking to the entire facts and circumstances of the



case, let the petitioner, above-named, be released on anticipatory bail in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, East Champaran, Motihari in connection with Motihari Town P.S. Case No.238 of 2018 subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
