2 30-07-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

In this case, the petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Manigachi (Bajitpur O.P.) P.S. Case No. 184 of 2018 registered for offences under sections 341, 323, 324, 307, 354(B), 435, 504/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

In the present case, though there is a direct allegation against the petitioner to have caused injury on the head of the Informant but, the injury report itself shows two injuries sustained by the victim which are simple in nature.

Looking to the entire facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.



10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Darbhanga in connection with Manigachi (Bajitpur O.P.) P.S. Case No. 184 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C. as also subject to condition that whenever the police will call the petitioner for investigation/interrogation, he will remain present and if he would not present himself, the privilege of grant of anticipatory bail shall be deemed to have been canceled.
