ORAL ORDER

3 08-01-2019 Considering the statements made in paragraph Nos.

5 and 6 of the show cause filed on behalf of the opposite parties,

the court is satisfied that the order of the writ court has been

complied with and there is no point to proceed any further.

Paragraphs 5 and 6 of the show cause are quoted below for

ready reference:-

“5. That it is stated that the petitioner has
already been paid her admissible benefits
and so far benefits of Assured Career
Progression is concerned she was found
entitled to a sum of Rs. 1,71,751/- (Rupees
one lakh seventy one thousand seven



hundred fifty one) only which was paid to her.

6. That it is stated that the petitioner was also found to be entitled for payment of Rs. 43,162/- (Forty three thousand one hundred sixty two) only towards earned leave (w.e.f. 31.10.2019 till 17.01.2010, i.e. for seventy nine days) and the same was also paid to her.”

In view of the above, the application stands disposed of.
