APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under
Sections 376(G) of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 3, 4 of
POCSO Act.

Allegation is that the petitioner committed rape upon
the victim.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
the petitioner is in custody since 31.01.2019. Charge sheet has
been submitted in this case. There is no allegation of tampering
of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The petitioner has
falsely been implicated in the present case. The victim has been
examined by the Medical Officer and F.S.L. report is Annexure
3 to the application. The medical report and the F.S.L. report do



not support the allegations made in the F.I.R.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned 1st Additional Sessions Judge/Special Judge, POCSO Act, Saran, Chapra in connection with Mashrakh P.S. case No.364 of 2018.
