4 27-09-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under
Section 384 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation is that an unknown person threatened and
demanded ransom from the informant through mobile.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
the petitioner is in custody since 8.2.2019. Charge sheet has
been submitted in this case. There is no allegation of tampering
of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The petitioner is not
named in the F.I.R. In the entire occurrence, the mobile is said
to have been used. The petitioner had no knowledge regarding
the same. The mobile of the petitioner was borrowed by the co-



villager. He has been made accused due to mistake of fact.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is not named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M. II, Danapur in connection with Rupaspur P.S. case No.180 of 2016.
