ORAL ORDER

2 09-08-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Chakiya P.S. Case no. 336 of 2018, registered under Sections 363, 366(A)/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The accusation is that minor daughter of the informant was kidnapped by Raja Paswan @ Raja Kumar (petitioner No.3) with the help of others boarding on Bolero. When informant reached at the house of Raja Paswan and made query then petitioner Nos. 1 and 2 started to abuse in Panchayat, while decision was made that family members of



the Raja Paswan will search his daughter, but they did not take any heed on it.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that due to love affairs, the daughter of the informant left her house with the petitioner No.3 Raja Paswan and performed marriage, which would appear from the statement of the victim recorded under Section 164 of the Cr.P.C. Further submission is that petitioner Nos. 1 and 2 have falsely been implicated in this case being the family members of petitioner No.3. The petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners, be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the A.C.J.M-XIV, East Champaran at Motihari in connection with Chakiya P.S. Case No. 336 of 2018, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
