2 06-08-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is languishing in custody for the
offence punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition
and Excise Act, 2016.

From a bag more than 8 liters of liquor was
recovered. The petitioner and co-accused were alleged to be
the person who had thrown the bag and fled away. The
petitioner has got criminal antecedent of identical nature.

Considering the facts of this case aforesaid, let the
petitioner, above named, be released on bail **if the trial is not
concluded within six months from the date of framing of the
charge** on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Twenty



Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court-below where the case is pending in connection with Siwan Town P.S. Case No.367 of 2019, with following conditions:

(a) Both the bailors shall be the resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned Court-below having immovable property in his name.

(b) The petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
