2 30-07-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with Chanpatia P.S. Case No. 104 of 2019 for the offence under Sections 366A/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 4 of the POCSO Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent and he is in custody since 11.06.2019.

Referring to the statement of the victim under Section 164 of the Cr.P.C., learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the victim has admitted the joining of wedlock at her own volition with the petitioner. He submits that the statement of the victim was recorded in presence of the father of the victim, the informant of this case.



Considering the aforesaid, the petitioner, named above, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Sessions Judge-I-cum-Special Judge (SC/ST/POCSO), Bettiah, West Champaran in connection with Chanpatia P.S. Case No. 104 of 2019.
