3 27-09-2019 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned APP for the State.

The petitioners seek regular bail in connection with Bhore P.S. Case No. 140 of 2019 for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 307, 302, 504, 506 and 324 of the Indian Penal Code .

The allegation is regarding the accused persons including the petitioners herein having arrived at the house of the informant and thereafter the accused persons had beaten the informant and others with *farsa, lathi, Danda, Bhala* etc.

The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that as



far as the petitioners herein are concerned, no specific overt act has been alleged against them by the informant, hence, their complicity in the matter is not established and they can at best be said to be member of the mob. Moreover, it is submitted that the petitioners are having clean antecedent and are languishing in custody since 22.04.2019. Nonetheless, the learned counsel appearing for the informant has vehemently opposed the prayer for bail.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioners, above named, are directed to be enlarged on regular bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gopalganj in connection with Bhore P.S. Case No. 140 of 2019.
