2 06-08-2019 This is an application for grant of anticipatory bail in connection with Kotwali P.S. Case No. 11 of 2019, disclosing offences under Sections 420/34 of IPC and Sections 63/65 of the Copyright Act.

Prosecution story is that duplicate Zarda (tobacco) was recovered from the shop of the petitioners.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioners is that they have falsely been implicated in this case and they are ready to abide by any conditions imposed upon them.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides, considering the above submission, this application is allowed. Let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the



court below within six weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bhagalpur, in connection with Kotwali P.S. Case No. 11 of 2019, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
