It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that
the instant application has been filed for commanding the
respondents to pay to the petitioner his post retiral benefits
along with interest thereon, arrears of salary and for other dues.
The petitioner retired in 2012 from the Bihar State Construction
Corporation Ltd.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that



matters of similar nature had travelled to the Apex Court in SLP No. 16159 of 2017 wherein it has been observed that in view of the action taken by the State Government with respect to the employees of the various Corporations, nothing further requires to be done and the Special Leave Petitions were disposed of.
