APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under Section
379/411 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegedly, while the informant was coming Kali Asthan
from Bauliya, the persons sitting on two motorcycles snatched
his mobile phone.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the
petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation
of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The
petitioner is in custody since 21-05-2019. Charge sheet has
already been submitted. The petitioner has been made accused
in the present case due to mistake of fact. The alleged mobile



phone is recovered from possession of the petitioner. The petitioner had no knowledge that the mobile in question is a stolen property.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is not named in the Complaint Case/F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rohtas at Sasaram in connection with Sasaram (Town) P.S. Case No. 86 of 2019.
