2 17-08-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and
learned counsel for the State.

In this case, the petitioners are seeking anticipatory
bail in connection with Jagdishpur P.S. Case No. 540 of 2017,
registered for the offence under Sections 341, 323, 363, 366,
504 and 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation has been made against the petitioners to
have kidnapped the daughter of the informant.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits the
petitioners are mother and uncle of Chandan Tani. The victim
girl has appeared before the Magistrate and stated that she of her
own has gone with Chandan Tanti having affair with him.



Looking to the aforesaid facts, let the above-named petitioners be released on anticipatory bail in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bhagalpur, in connection with Jagdishpur P.S. Case no. 540 of 2017, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
