ORAL ORDER

2 17-08-2019 Heard both sides.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in Complaint
Case No.154C of 2015 for the offences allegedly committed by
the petitioner under Sections 498A, 323, 341, 379 and 494 of
the Indian Penal Code and under Section 3/4 of the D.P. Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is the husband of the complainant and he is ready to
keep his wife with all honour and dignity. On such, learned
counsel for the complainant submits that the complainant is also
willing to live with her husband.

Considering the willingness of the parties, the above



named petitioner is directed to surrender in the court below within four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order and the court below shall enlarge the petitioner on provisional bail for four months on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned S.D.J.M., Hilsa (Nalanda) in connection with Complaint Case No.154C of 2015, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C. and the court below shall make efforts for reconciliation between the husband and the wife. If the dispute is resolved and the petitioner keeps his wife properly, the provisional bail granted to the petitioner shall be confirmed and if the dispute is not resolved between the husband and the wife, the court below shall pass order in accordance with law on the provisional bail of the petitioner immediately after lapse of four months.
