APP for the State.

By order dated 17.08.2019, the notice was issued to the opposite party no. 2. It appears from the service report that notice has been validly served upon opposite party no.2 but there is no appearance on behalf of opposite party no. 2.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner's marriage has been solemnized 10 years ago therefore no case is made out under Section 498A of the Indian Penal Code. He further submits that petitioner is ready to keep his wife with full honour and dignity.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, let the



petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of the order, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Araria in connection with Complaint Case No. 532C of 2013, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
