In this case, the petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in connection with Banka (Mahila) P.S. Case No. 16 of 20019, registered for the offence under Sections 498(A), 354(B), 120-B and 509/34 of the Indian Penal Code and under Section 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

The petitioners are mother-in-law and father-in-law of the informant.

Looking to the entire facts and circumstances of the case, let the above-named petitioners be released on anticipatory bail in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned



Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Banka, in connection with Banka (Mahila) P.S. Case no. 16 of 2019, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
