3 20-11-2019 Heard Mr. Sanjay Kumar Jha learned Advocate for the petitioner and Mr. Gauri Shankar Gupta, learned APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Kaluwahi P.S. Case No. 79 of 2019 instituted for the offences under Sections 271, 273, 413 and 414/14 of the Indian Penal Code.

From the possession of the petitioner, 150 literes of Nepali country made liquor has been recovered.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that he has been arrested on mistaken identity. In fact, four persons who were chased by the police and out of the confusion, the petitioner was arrested. The document suggesting recovery of liquor from the possession of the petitioner has been prepared



for the purposes of prosecuting the petitioner. In the cases which have been lodged against the petitioner, he is on bail.

Considering the the period of custody of the petitioner which is from 10.06.2019, he is directed to be released on bail on her furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned 2nd Additional District and Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, Excise Act, Madhubani in connection with Kaluwahi P.S. Case No. 79 of 2019.
