3 16-11-2019 This application, for grant of anticipatory bail, arises out of Dinara P.S. Case No. 23 of 2019, disclosing offences under Sections 341, 323, 379, 498(A), 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Petitioner happens to be husband of the informant and allegation against him of assaulting the informant and threatening to burn her.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is that entire allegation is false and concocted and as a matter of fact, she is not ready to reside with the petitioner rather she wants to reside in her maik and due to which, present case has been filed.

Heard learned A.P.P. also. Earlier notice was issued to informant, which was validly served upon informant and a



Vakalatnama has also been filed on behalf of informant but none has appeared on behalf of informant on repeated calls.

Considering the facts and circumstances, this application is allowed. Let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within six weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned SDJM, Bikramganj, Rohtas, in connection with Dinara P.S. Case No. 23 of 2019, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
