4 22-11-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Balia P.S.
Case No. 117 of 2018, registered for offence punishable under
Sections 353, 307, 34 of the Indian Penal Code and 25(1-AA),
25(1-A), 25(1-D), 25(1-B)a, 26, 27, 35 of the Arms Act.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
submits that the petitioner is quite innocent and has falsely been
implicated in the instant case. It is further submitted that nothing
has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. There
is a complete violation of provisions under Section 100 Cr.P.C.
The petitioner is languishing in custody since 15.05.2018.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case
and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let the



above-named petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Begusarai, in connection with Balia P.S. Case No. 117 of 2018.
