2 09-08-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is languishing in custody for the offence
under Sections 394 of the Indian Penal Code.

The FIR of the occurrence of robbery is against unknown.

Submission is that the petitioner is in custody since
02.02.2019. He was never put on TIP during investigation nor
any incriminating article was recovered from possession of the
petitioner. Similarly situated some other co-accused Sanoj
Kumar @ Indal has already been allowed bail by coordinate
Bench of this Court vide Annexure-2.

Considering the aforesaid fact, let the petitioner, above
named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.
20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like



amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Gwalpara P.S. Case No. 15 of 2019, with following conditions:

(a) Both the bailors shall be the resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned Court below having immovable property in his name.

(b) The petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
