Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 363, 366 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner is of kidnapping of the minor daughter of the informant. In the statement, under Section 164 Cr.P.C., the victim stated that the petitioner played active role in her kidnapping. Co-accused Chandan Sah, was also involved in the occurrence. The last statement, which she made before the court was that the accused person wanted to show the people that the victim has fled away with them and just to lower the image of the parents, the act has been committed. The petitioner is in custody since 14.12.2018. Investigation of the case is



already complete against the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the informant opposed the prayer for bail.

Considering the entire facts, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Pipara P.S. Case No. 294 of 2017, with following conditions:

(a) Both the bailors shall be the resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned Court below having immovable property in his name.

(b) The petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
