2 11-01-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

Petitioner is in custody in connection with Excise
Case No. 18 of 2018, Special Case No. 1200 of 2018 for the
alleged offence under 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise
Act.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner submits
that the petitioner is in custody since 06.10.2018 in connection
with seizure of 63.750 liters of Royal Stag English Wine. He
further submits that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent
and the seizure was only empty formality and has been falsely
implicated in the case. The vehicle from which the contraband
was seized does not belong to the petitioner.



Considering the totality of the facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Additional Sessions Judge 2nd -cum-Special Judge, Excise Act, Araria in connection with Excise Case No. 18/2018, Special Case No. 1200/2018.
