3 16-11-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending her arrest in a case
registered for the offence punishable under Sections 302, 201,
34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Prosecution case as lodged by the informant is that
her daughter has been killed by the accused persons and her
dead body has also been disposed of.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is
no specific allegation against the petitioner and the petitioner is
the mother-in-law of the deceased. He further submits that the
husband of the deceased is in jail.



In the facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of her arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of the order, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M., Bhojpur at Ara in connection with Piro Police Station Case No. 93 of 2019, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
