ORAL ORDER

2 13-08-2019 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

This application for anticipatory bail arises out of Kurtha P.S. Case NO. 52 of 2019, disclosing offences under Sections 341,323,324,325,307,354,504 and 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

There eleven persons named in the First Information Report including the present petition. It is evident from the First Information Report that the occurrence had taken place because of land dispute. Allegedly, all the persons named in the First Information Report started assaulting the informant's husband and others. It is evident from the First Information Report that the allegations are of general and omnibus nature.

Considering the nature of allegation, this application is allowed.



Let the petitioner above named in the event of his arrest/surrender within six weeks from today in the Court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Arwal in Kurtha P.S. Case No. 52 of 2019, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

This is subject to the condition that the petitioner shall present himself before the Police/Court, as the case may be, as and when required and in the event of failure on his part to appear before the Court on two consecutive occasions, his bail bonds shall be liable to be cancelled.
