Service was communicated to the Registrar, Aryabhata Knowledge University but there is no follow of action by the Aryabhata Knowledge University.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the requisite fee alongwith application in prescribed format has been submitted by the petitioner to the Aryabhata Knowledge University.
