ORAL ORDER

3 16-11-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

Petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with
Kateya P.S. Case No. 86 of 2019 registered for the offence
punishable under Sections 341, 323, 324, 325, 307, 504, 506/34
of the Indian Penal Code.

While the informant was present in his house along
with his family members, four named accused persons including
the petitioner armed with weapons descended there and
petitioner assaulted on the hand of the informant by means of
rod while other accused persons assaulted his other family
members by means of knife and lathi.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner



that the petitioner has no concern with the aforesaid occurrence. Petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case by the informant due to petty dispute with him, who happens to be his neighbour. Allegation against the petitioner is of assaulting the informant at his hand i.e. on non-vital part. On examination of the informant, doctor has found swelling on his left hand. Though, opinion regarding nature of injury has been reserved on 06.03.2019 but, despite passing away more than eight months, final injury report has not been brought on record by the prosecution. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M.-XV, Gopalganj in connection with Kateya P.S. Case No. 86 of 2019, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
