Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is the husband of the complainant and he is ready to keep his wife with full honour and dignity.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of six weeks from the



date of receipt of the order, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Benipur, Darbhanga in connection with Complaint Case No. 68 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
