2 05-09-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with
Kankarbagh P.S. Case No. 460 of 2019 for the offences under
Sections 392 and 414 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would submits that
the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent.

The allegation against the petitioner is that he was
involved in snatching mobile of the informant. The petitioner
and co-accused, namely, Sonu Kumar, were apprehended by the
police and on search looted mobile was recovered from the
possession of the co-accused.

The petitioner is in custody since 12.05.2019.



Considering the fact that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent and recovery of looted mobile was not from the possession of the petitioner, the Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, let the petitioner, named above, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Patna in connection with Kankarbagh P. S. Case No. 460 of 2019.
