2 23-08-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under
Section 392 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation is that three unknown miscreants on the
point of arms snatched a bag containing Rs.24 lacs of the
informant.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
the petitioner is in custody since 31.07.2018 and has got no
criminal antecedent. Charge sheet has been submitted in this
case. There is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged
against the petitioner. The petitioner is not named in the F.I.R.
His name has come on confessional statement of co-accused.
There is no recovery of any incriminating article from the



possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has not been put on T.I.P.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is not named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M. VI, Araria in connection with Forbishganj (Simraha) P.S. case No.127 of 2018.
