The petitioner apprehends his arrest in Bhargama P.S. Case No.80 of 2019, registered under Sections 379, 411 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The informant alleged that his buffaloes were stolen and during the course of search, the informant found his buffaloes loaded on a pick up van. Bhutai Yadav, the driver of the pick up van, was apprehended.

It is submitted that the name of the petitioner was disclosed by Bhutai Yadav in his confessional statement. Save and except the confession of Bhutai Yadav, there is no material that the petitioner committed any theft of buffaloes of the informant and petitioner has got no criminal antecedent.

Taking into consideration the facts aforesaid, let



petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of the order, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Araria in connection with Bhargama P.S. Case No.80 of 2019, subject to the conditions laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
