ORAL ORDER

2 30-08-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under Section 414 of the Indian Penal Code.

A stolen motorcycle was allegedly recovered from possession of co-accused Arjun Kumar and he disclosed to the police that the petitioner was also his criminal associates. Petitioner has got no criminal antecedent.

Considering the facts aforesaid that there is no direct and admissible evidence against the petitioner, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Kateya Police



Station Case No. 206 of 2019, subject to the following conditions:-

(a) The petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the learned court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.

(b) Both the bailors shall be resident of the territorial jurisdiction of the learned court below.
