Petitioner apprehends his arrest in Jalalgarh P.S. Case
No.43 of 2019, registered under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323,
324, 307 and 427 of the Indian Penal Code and 27 of the Arms
Act.

The informant alleged that at about 12.15 in the night,
15-20 criminals came to his house and made indiscriminate
firing on the informant and his son. The informant and his son
got firearm injury. The criminals were in search of his son, Ram
Prasad Swarnkar. The informant further alleged that Arun
Vishwas who had picked up quarrel with the son of the
informant along with other accused persons had conspired to
kill his son.



Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has got enmity and that is why petitioner has falsely been implicated in the case. The admitting enmity with the petitioner has been admitted by the informant himself in his fardbeyan. There is no allegation of firing against the petitioner but it appears that the petitioner was instrumental and on account of enmity, the petitioner conspired and it was the petitioner and his men who made indiscriminate firing causing firearm injury to the informant and his son.

Considering the facts aforesaid, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on anticipatory bail. Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is rejected.
