ORAL ORDER

2 28-08-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Madhuban P.S. Case No. 48 of 2019, registered under
Section 30(a) of the Bihar Excise Act, 2016.

The accusation is of recovery of 48 bottles each
containing 180 ml Indian made foreign liquor near the poultry
farm of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that it
would appear from the F.I.R. that the alleged Indian made
foreign liquor was not recorded from the poultry farm of the
petitioner rather the same was recovered near his poultry farm
and petitioner has no criminal antecedent.



Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Special Judge, Excise, Motihari, East Champaran, in connection with Madhuban P.S. Case No. 48 of 2019, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
