2 29-08-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and
learned APP for the State.

Petitioners seek bail in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Section 30(a)Bihar Prohibition and
Excise Act, 2016.

Huge quantity of liquor was recovered from the
Scorpio of which one of the petitioners was driver and another
was a cleaner. Petitioners have stated on oath that they have got
no criminal antecedent. They are in custody since 09.07.2019.

Let the petitioners, above named, be released on
bail **after framing of the charges** on furnishing bail bonds of
Rs.20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) each with two sureties of the



like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Balrampur (Telta O.P.) Police Station Case No.81 of 2019, subject to the condition that both bailors shall be resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned court below and further the petitioners shall fully cooperate with the investigation of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioners.
