ORAL ORDER

2 03-09-2019 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

This application for anticipatory bail arises out of Rajnagar P.S. Case NO. 402 of 2018, disclosing offences under Sections 323,341,379,307,504/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

There are five persons named in the First Information Report.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that there is no specific allegation of any overt act against this petitioner and only such allegation is against co-accused Ramashish.

On perusal of the First Information Report, I find substance in the submission so advanced on behalf of the petitioner.

This application is, accordingly, allowed.



Let the petitioner above named in the event of his arrest/surrender within six weeks from today in the Court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned ACJM-I, Madhubani in Rajnagar P.S. Case No. 402 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

This is subject to the condition that the petitioner shall present himself before the Police/Court, as the case may be, as and when required and in the event of failure on his part to appear before the Court on two consecutive occasions, his bail bonds shall be liable to be cancelled.
