Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that petition no. 1 is the husband and petitioner no.2 is father-in-law and so, they should be allowed anticipatory bail.

Learned APP opposed the same.

In the facts and circumstances, as discussed



hereinabove, prayer for anticipatory bail is rejected.

Furthermore, the stay granted to the petitioners vide
order dated 29.08.2019 stands vacated.
