ORAL ORDER

2 30-08-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

Petitioners are in custody in connection with Andhramath P.S. Case No. 106 of 2019 for the offence under sections 272, 273, 414 of the Indian Penal Code and section 30(a) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Learned counsel submits that total 25.800 liters of liquor was seized from the possession of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are in custody since 3.7.2019.



Considering the fact that petitioners have no criminal antecedent, the Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioners, let the petitioners, named above, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional District and Sessions Judge-II-cum-Special Judge, Excise Act, Madhubani, in connection with Andhramath P.S. Case No.106 of 2019.
