2 30-08-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under
Section 392 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation is that three unknown miscreants on the
point of pistol snatched the motorcycle and mobile from the
informant.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
the petitioner is in custody since 13.03.2019. Charge sheet has
been submitted in this case. There is no allegation of tampering
of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The petitioner is not
named in the F.I.R. The petitioner had no knowledge that the
motorcycle in question is stolen property. Said motorcycle has



not been put on T.I.P. The petitioner has been made accused due to mistake of fact.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is not named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned M. Shukla, Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate, 1st class, Lakhisarai in connection with Birupur P.S. case No.16 of 2018.
