The petitioner is in custody since 30.07.2019 in connection with Gr. No.734 of 2019 arising out of Nabinagar P.S. Case No.188 of 2019 registered for the offence under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the alleged recoveries were not from the conscious possession of the petitioner but from the dicky of the car.
