2 30-08-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case instituted for the
offences under Sections 457 and 380 of the Indian Penal Code.

Prosecution allegation, in short, is that the many
articles and cash amount were looted from the shop of the
informant.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
the petitioner is in custody since 26.6.2019 and has got no
criminal antecedent. Charge-sheet/prosecution report has been
submitted in this case. There is no allegation of tampering of
witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The petitioner is not
named in the F.I.R. The name of the petitioner has transpired on
the basis of confession of co-accused. The petitioner had no



knowledge that mobile in question is stolen property. The petitioner has not been put on T.I.P.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is not named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, it is directed that the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Nawada in connection with Hisua P.S. Case No. 33/2019.
