The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied in case they are granted liberty to file representation before the respondent no.3 and the respondent no.3 may be directed to dispose of the representation of the petitioners within a specified time frame.

Accordingly, it is directed that the petitioners shall file a representation before the respondent no.3 regarding their grievances raised in the writ petition within a period of four



weeks from today and the respondent no.3 is directed to dispose of the same within a period of twelve weeks thereafter, considering the orders dated 21.8.2017 and 18.10.2017 passed by the District Teachers Appointment Appellate Authority, Patna as also the resolution of the Education Department dated 08.08.2013, which shall be produced by the petitioners before the respondent no.3.

The present writ petition is disposed of on the aforesaid terms.
