2 08-04-2019 The learned counsel for the parties are in agreement that the present case is squarely covered by a judgment of the Apex Court in the case of ***Mukesh & Anr. Vs. The State of Bihar & Ors.***, reported in ***(2017) 5 SCC 383***, hence the writ application can be disposed off with liberty to the petitioner to file representation before the respondent authorities.

Having regard to the submissions made by the learned counsel for the parties, the present writ application is disposed off with liberty to the petitioner to file representation before the respondent no. 4 enclosing a copy of this order and the judgment of the Apex Court in the case of Mukesh & Anr.
