Petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with
Rigilganj PS Case No.184/19 , registered for offences punishable
under Sections 341, 323, 504, 506, 427, 354/34 of the Indian
Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

As per FIR petitioner and other accused persons
snatched the papers from the informant and there also
allegation of firing.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is
that during the investigation story of firing has not been found
true and the petitioner has falsely been implicated. He is a

Having heard both sides and in view of the facts and circumstances, as stated above, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned J.M. Ist Class, Saran at Chapra in connection with Rigilganj P.S. Case No.184 of 2019, subject to conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
