APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case instituted for the offences under Sections 376, 511, 323, 504, 506 of the Indian Penal Code and 4, 8 and 12 of POCSO Act.

The prosecution allegation in short is that the accused persons entered into the house of the informant and misbehaved with her.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is in custody since 13.5.2019 and has got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. Charge-sheet has been submitted in the present case. The petitioner is non-else but the own uncle of the informant. There is a family dispute in respect



of the property. For the said reason, he has falsely been implicated in the present case. Except for this, there is no other substantive evidence to suggest his implication in the present case.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R..

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, it is directed that the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge -1st -cum- Special Judge, POCSO Act, Begusarai in connection with Birpur P.S. Case No. 62/2019.
