2 18-10-2019 Learned counsel appearing on behalf of petitioner is permitted to make necessary correction in para 8 of the petition during the course of the day.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with Angarh P.S. Case No. 05 of 2019 for the offences under Section 392 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent and he is in custody since 07.06.2019. He further submits that petitioner was not named in the F.I.R. and his name surfaced on the confessional statement of co-accused Niyamutullah, yet he has not been put on TIP.

Considering the fact that petitioner has no criminal



antecedent, the Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, let the petitioner, named above, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Purnea in connection with Angarh P.S. Case No. 05 of 2019.
