3 24-09-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and
learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioners are in custody since 05.07.2019 in connection with Parsauni P.S. Case No. 56 of 2019 registered for the offence punishable under Sections 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition & Excise Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioner No.2 is merely a driver and petitioner No. 1 is the passenger of the vehicle from which the alleged recoveries of liquor is said to have been made. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the petitioners have no criminal antecedents and the alleged recoveries were not from their conscious possession.



Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances, let the petitioners above named be released on bail, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned 2nd Additional Sessions Judge cum Special judge, Excise Act, Sitamarhi, in connection with Parsauni P.S. Case No. 56 of 2019.
