Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is languishing in custody for the offences punishable under Sections 364A/120B/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Submission is that though allegation is of kidnapping for ransom but fact is that the informant had taken money through his maternal uncle from several person for managing installation of mobile towers. However, he misappropriated the money. Hence, he was detained for one day only by some other person just to recover the money.

Considering the facts aforesaid and the statement of the petitioner on oath that he has got no criminal antecedent, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing



bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court-below where the case is pending in connection with Nasriganj P.S. Case No.113 of 2019, with following conditions:

(a) Both the bailors shall be the resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned Court-below.

(b) The petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
