Petitioner's claim on account of first, second and third



benefits under Assured Career Progression Scheme as well as benefits on account of revision was made before respondent No 3 vide Annexure 3. The short submission made by the petitioner's counsel is that the petitioner's claim, contained in Annexure 3/A, be disposed of by respondent No 2.
